

Evaluations can be costly. It is critically important that they are done correctly on the first visit. Our team is here to help and support the process of getting the right evaluation you need, the first time you go.

What to know before you go:

- When making first contact with an evaluator, inform them that you are seeking an evaluation as a licensee of the Oregon State Board of Nursing.
- The evaluator must follow the American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) for assessing individuals to evaluate for substance use and mental health disorders.
- The evaluator must be qualified and competent in using the current version of the DSM diagnostic code manual.
- The evaluator must be able to provide return-to-work recommendations.
